RE: Exclusion of LGBTIQA+ people from Census

Dear Hon. Tony Zappia MP

As the peak body for LGBTIQA+ South Australians, we write to seek your support to urge the federal government to reverse its decision to exclude LGBTIQA+ people from the 2026 Census.

Currently we do not know how many LGBTIQA+ people there are in Australia or where they live because the 2021 national census did not include questions on gender identity, sexual orientation and variations in intersex characteristics.

The Australian Bureau of Statistics has since issued a statement of regret and has worked actively with our communities to consult on questions that would count LGBTIQA+ identities.

Our communities have therefore been devastated by the federal government's recent announcement that it will not include these questions.

LGBTIQA+ people experience significantly poorer health and social outcomes than the general population. To address this disparity, we need a population-level evidence base to develop effective policy and programs that improve the health of all Australians.

SARAA are frequently approached by state and local policy makers for data about the needs of LGBTIQA+ South Australians.

Currently this information is unavailable and, as a result of the government's decision, will remain so until at least 2031.

Put simply, this is a once in a 5-year opportunity that we cannot afford to miss.

We urge you to stand with LGBTIQA+ South Australians and call on the federal government to reverse its decision to exclude LGBTIQA+ people from the 2026 Census.
